# **Minutes of the Meeting**

Item 2.1	The Chairman of the meeting formally welcomed the hon'ble members of the Board and introduced them the credentials of the Institution and of the Department. Item 2.2	Confirmation of the Minutes of the First meeting of the Board of Studies (Business Administration) held on 27-August-2020 was done by presenting the summary of suggestions made by the Board then, and the actions taken by the Department in the process of implementing those suggestions. Members have unanimously agreed to the fulfilment of the suggestions and expressed satisfaction. They suggested to include Simple Case Studies in "Principles of Management" and "Principles of Entrepreneurship".  The finalised curriculum for First Year courses is shown as <b>Annexure-I.</b>

Item 2.3	<ul> <li>The modified curriculum of the B.B.A. programme was presented by the Professor and Head of the Department of Commerce and Management, and same was deliberated in detail by the members of the Board. Their suggestions in this regard included:</li> <li>1. "Marketing Research" can be named as "Business Research" and the contents be framed accordingly.</li> <li>2. "Creativity and Innovation Management" can be included as DSE, in stead of "Insurance Principles and Practice".</li> <li>3. "Business Analytics" may be introduced replacing the course on "Resource Management Techniques".</li> </ul>
	The revised curriculum is accordingly prepared and the same is shown as <b>Annexure-II</b> .
