Minutes of the Second Meeting of BoS – Commerce

The meeting deliberated the items of Agenda that had been proposed by the Chairman, and after detailed discussions the following were approved by the Board formally:

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ltem 2.1	The Chairman of the meeting formally welcomed the hon'ble members of the Board and briefed them the recently attained credentials of the Institution and of the Department. The members have expressed their appreciations for the achievements of the Institution.
Item 2.2	Confirmation of the Minutes of the First meeting of the Board of Studies (Commerce) held on 08-August-2022 was done by presenting the summary of suggestions made by the Board then, and the actions taken by the Department in the process of implementing those suggestions. Members have unanimously agreed to the fulfilment of the suggestions and expressed satisfaction.
Item 2.3	In order to ensure better employability and industry-readiness of the Graduates of B.Com PA and BCOM CMA program, the curriculum of B.Com_Professional Accounting program is mapped completely with that of Chartered Accountancy program (Foundation and Intermediate levels), thus enabling the students of B.Com. PA parallelly pursue C.A. qualification comfortably and similarly B.Com_Cost and Management Accounting program is mapped completely with that of the professional program in Cost and Management Accountancy (Foundation and Intermediate levels), thus enabling the students of B.Com. Cost and Management Accountancy (Foundation and Intermediate levels), thus enabling the students of B.Com. CMA parallelly pursue CMA .
	The curriculum and syllabi of both the courses (B.com professional Accounting and B.Com Cost and Management Accounting) are revisited and revised incorporating any changes made in the curriculum and syllabi of the professional exams as and when notified by the respective professional bodies.
	As such, the curriculum is revisited, and certain sweeping changes have been made – by rearranging courses and improvising the syllabi of many courses and introducing new courses ,
	The duly amended curriculum of the program as approved by the Board of Studies in the First meeting held on 8-8-2022 is presented as Annexure-I.
	The list of courses newly introduced/ rearranged in the improvised curriculum with rationale for the inclusion/change is highlighted and presented as Annexure-II.
	The Syllabi for II, III and IV Semesters under R-20 regulations for Bachelor of Commerce(Professional Accounting), (Cost and Management Accounting), (Accounting and Finance) for students admitted in year 22-23 were deliberated in detail and members suggested the following modifications to be made in appropriately:
	1. It was recommended to rework on the Department vision and Mission statement by referring the same with vision and Mission statements of respective Departments of other renowned universities
	2. It was suggested to follow either MLA or APA Format in textbook and reference book citation and also update the same accordingly
	3.It was advised to modify the course objectives and course outcomes of DSE-I Human Behaviour paper and Revise the entire syllabus
	4. It was suggested to confine the Syllabus of Unit II Cost Accounting of BCOM PA and Unit II Cost and Management Accounting-I of BCOM CMA (Annexure – II)
	5. In BCOM Accounting and Finance , It was recommended to replace Unit II Self-Balancing Ledgers of Accounting for Business paper with Partnership Accounting



 6. The Board suggested to think of the following for future implementations: Introduction of new age courses like "Block Chain Technology", "Artificial intellige discussing its impact on Accounting and Finance 7. The members of the board suggested to keep "Direct Tax" in BCOM PA and "Income paper in BCOM CMA as two papers "Income Tax Laws and Practice-I and Income Tax and Practice-II" as a common paper to both the courses in 3rd and 4th Semesters. The was discussed in detail and was unanimously approved by the members of the E (Annexure – II) 			
 8. Suggested to use the appropriate course title for subjects which will give an idea about the Course content (syllabus) present in the title 			
9. The members of the board suggested to rename - Cost Accounting paper in Semester II and Cost and Management Accounting paper in Semester III of BCom CMA as Cost and Management Accounting-I and Cost and Management Accounting – II (Annexure – II)			
10. Considering the core Objectives of BCOM PA and BCOM CMA it is suggested by the members to include internship program in the sixth semester and allow Students in their sixth semester to engage in internship and project work with professional accounting firms.
